1. The Cooperative Youth Leadership Camp is open to high school (public, private or homeschool) juniors in La Plata, Archuleta, Hinsdale, Mineral and San Juan counties. (The children, grandchildren, brothers or sisters of La Plata Electric Association, Inc. employees or directors are eligible to participate in the Cooperative Youth Leadership Camp.)

Applicants should have a strong academic record, be interested in enhancing their leadership potential and have an interest in meeting new people.
3. Compositions must be formatted and typed using size 12 Arial or Times New Roman font. Double-spaced on one side of each page.
