Robert Lloyd promoted to LPEA Inventory Control Specialist

Fills position made available by retiring James Forsythe

DURANGO, Colo. – Warehouse Storekeeper Robert Lloyd has been promoted to Inventory Control Specialist at La Plata Electric Association (LPEA), overseeing inventory and assisting LPEA's line crews with materials needed for repair and maintenance of the electric system. Lloyd was awarded the position vacated by James Forsythe, who recently retired.

A long-time La Plata County resident, Lloyd joined the LPEA Operations team in 2012, coming to the cooperative from the line construction company WESODI, where he had worked for six years. Serving first as a groundman at WESODI, and eventually promoted to equipment operator, Lloyd gained familiarity with LPEA's system, literally from the ground up. He also filled in temporarily in LPEA's warehouse in 2007-2008.

Originally from Texas, Lloyd moved to La Plata County in 1983 to assist his grandparents on their ranch near Saul's Creek. He then worked a variety of jobs, eventually hired on at South City Market, where he was employed for 18 years before joining WESODI.

Lloyd has resided with his family in the Oxford area for the past 16 years.
