APPROVAL OF AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

MARCH FINANCIALS REVIEW – ACTUALS

VP Berry provided a brief overview of March's financials, which were presented at the Board meeting last month. The overview included performance, detailed insights, and addressing operating variance inquiries. VP Berry took all questions.

APRIL FINANCIALS REVIEW - PRELIMINARY

VP Berry provided a brief initial report on the April financials, including a summary of key figures from the balance sheet and fielded inquiries from the committee. Early numbers look flat but with some variances. Discussion ensued on the importance of tree trimming to reduce fire risk, considering its impact on the budget allocation for fire prevention measures.

POTENTIAL EXECUTIVE SESSION

Committee Chair Wheeler requested a motion to move into an executive session to discuss 2023 audited financials, a FastTrack Communication update, and a FERC Filing (Federal Energy Regulatory Commission) update.

2023 AUDITED FINANCIALS REVIEW

FASTTRACK COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE

This item was deliberated upon during the executive session.

PACE FINANCIAL MODELING

VP Berry delivered a presentation on the LPEA PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy) Loan application, covering its overview, the financial advantages of the project, and the financing parameters and strategy. LPEA submitted a PACE loan application in the summer of 2023 to build 5 MW of solar with 5 MW/20MWh of energy storage. The current estimated capital project budget stands at \$17,888,600, with a projected completion timeframe of five years. Considering the timing of the application, the total RUS loan amount would be \$13,416,450, with 40% eligible for forgiveness. LPEA was granted PACE loan forgiveness in the first quarter of 2024. VP Berry and Interim CEO Smith answered all the questions regarding the PACE modeling.
