



Criteria to become a LPEA Qualified Solar Installer

*Not Required

- *NABCEP certified professional. The North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP) is the most respected, well-established, and widely recognized national certification organization for professionals in the field of renewable energy.
- Be in business for at least 12 months within La Plata Electric Association service territory under the same leadership and corporate name and can provide a business license.
- Respond to customer complaints timely and efficiently.
- Respond and correct failed inspections within two weeks.
- Complete LPEA's Qualified Solar Installer Training and demonstrate the ability to follow LPEA's policies and procedures.
- Successfully completed 2 or more projects in our service territory in the last 12 months (with no issues).
- Have not received more than 2 written complaints in the last 12 months from LPEA's members; and have no unresolved written correction requests from LPEA.
- Sign LPEA's Ethics Pledge, committing them to conduct their business with integrity, honesty, quality, and with environmental, social, and financial responsibility.
- Carry liability insurance of \$1,000,000.
- Follow up with customers after completion to ensure proper connection to LPEA's grid.
- Have company logos on company vehicles and workers' uniforms.
