WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed the 2019 Financial Forecast.;
and


WHEREAS, La Plata Electric Association has reduced the operating expenses associated with rental street lighting by \$180,000 annually due an LED retrofit;
and

WHEREAS, a temporary incentive from Tri-State to support Time of Use programs in the amount of \$130,000 annually has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed a 12.5% rate reduction to the Street Lighting rate tariff amounting to \$90,000 and a 2.5% rate increase to the Residential and Single Phase Small Commercial Time of Use rate tariffs amounting to \$130,000;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of La Plata Electric Association, Inc. that the modifications to rate schedules are hereby approved and shall take effect January 1, 2019, which is at least 30 days after public notice will be provided as required by C.R.S. section 40-9.5-106.
